## **Broker certification**

To become a MetroPlusHealth Medicare Broker, you will need to complete the **2026 Medicare Training** and the MetroPlusHealth **2026 Annual Compliance Training.** 

Before you start the training modules keep this in mind:

- ✓ The training must be done in one sitting, otherwise you will need to start from the beginning.\*
- ✓ You will have 2 attempts of getting a passing score of 85%. After your first attempt, you will get a score immediately. If you fail, you can re-take it on the same page.
- ✓ If you fail on your second try, you will need to re-take the Medicare Broker Product Training by using the same link below.

Note: Please use **Google Chrome** for this training.

The completion attestation is embedded within each link. Once you have completed each of the modules, it will automatically direct you to the form.

Failure to complete both training modules will affect your appointment to sell the MetroPlusHealth 2026 Medicare plans.




