Dear Valued Member,

We're happy to share that NY State of Health will continue to offer Cost Sharing Reductions (CSRs) for Qualified Health Plans through the end of 2026. These Cost-Sharing Reductions reduce your out-of-pocket costs, like co-pays when you go to the doctor, co-insurance, deductibles, and the maximum out-of-pocket limit. **You must enroll in a Silver Plan to receive these Cost Sharing Reductions.** More information can be found [here](#).

You can switch to a Silver health plan.

If you currently have a Bronze, Gold, or Platinum health plan, you can now switch to a Silver plan. This is because new cost-saving options are available to you. You have 60 days to make this change. If you do change health plans, your deductible and max out-of-pocket may reset.

How to switch:

- Log in to your NY State of Health account online.
- Or, call customer service at 1-855-355-5777.

Don't have a health plan yet?

If you are not currently enrolled in a health plan, you can still enroll. You have 60 days to do so.
